Days: 85
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Pink
Season: Late-Season
6' vigorous tomato plants that yield abundant crops of 8-oz, rose-pink tomatoes. Well balanced sweet/tart flavor.



Beefsteak

Days: 85
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Red
Season: Late-Season
4 to 5-inch, slightly ribbed, bright-red tomatoes that have spectacularly delicious, sweet flavors.



Brandywine

Days: 85
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Red/Pink
Season: Late-Season
Prolific potato leaf plant producing 1-2 lb. large, red/pink fruit. Excellent flavor!



Bread and Salt Oxheart

Color: Red
Season: Mid-Season
The fruit is a large with dense, meaty flesh. It is exquisite for slicing, sauce making and everything in between.



Abe Lincoln

Brilliant red, round, medium sized fruit that grows in clusters. 12 oz. fruit with delicious flavor.



German Red Strawberry Oxheart

Large, oxheart-shaped tomatoes. Plants yield an abundance of meaty, 3-inch wide by 3 1/2-inch long fruit that can grow to 1 lb.

Beautiful, red heirloom beefsteak fruits average 4 to 5" in diameter and weigh up to 1-1/2 pounds. Fruits have good flavor, are low in acid and are moderately sweet.

One of your first ripe tomatoes, but produces throughout the season. produces 2" flavorful slicers.

Sets an abundance of flavorful, 7oz. fruit. Bushy plant with large leaves shade the fruit preventing sunscald.

Oxheart

Color: Red

Season: Mid to Late Season

Dense fruit with few seeds cooks down to robust sauce, roasts well and is a star slicer.



Stupice

Days: 60

Plant Size: Indeterminate

Color: Red

Season: Early-Season

Cold-tolerant tomato that bears an abundance of very sweet, flavorful 2 to 3-inch, deep red fruit. Sweet/acid, flavor and high production. Grows fine in containers too.



Thessaloniki

Color: Red

Season: Mid-Season

Plants are productive. Fruits are red, 6-18 oz. each, with firm flesh that has a slightly sweet, berry-like flavor and a tart aftertaste. Resistant to sunburn, spots and cracking.

Roma

Classic Italian plum shaped tomato. Meaty with few seeds. Great for paste, canning and sauce.



San Marzano

Season: Mid-Season

Thick and meaty flesh that's perfect for sauces and pastes. Great candidate for oven-drying.

A dependable crop of large, uniform fruit that sets well and will make sauce, paste, salsa or sliceβs.

Purple Varieties



Black from Tula

Days: 75-80

Color: Purple-Black
Season: Mid to Late-Season
Deep reddish-brown beefsteak has a rich, sweet flavor that is delicious. Fruit is smooth in texture and weighs from 8-12 oz. This outstanding variety is very productive and seems to set well even when weather turns hot.



Black Krim

Season: Mid-Season
3-4" slightly flattened mahogany-colored tomatoes with deep green shoulders. Green gel around seeds. Intense, slightly salty taste. One of my favorite tomatoes. Perfect choice for slicing, salads and cooking.



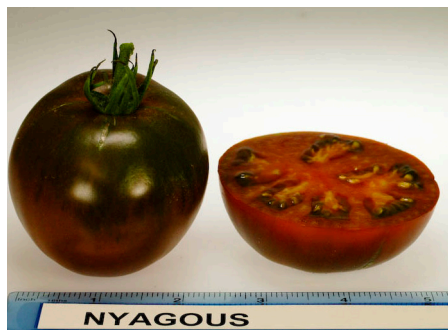
Cherokee Purple

Color: Purple-Black
Season: Late-Season
Very productive plants produce loads of dusky rose to purple colored, 12 oz.-1 lb. beefsteak tomatoes with deep red colors to the interior flesh and dark shoulders. Rich, complex and sweet flavors.



Japanese Black Trifele

Days: 75
Size: Indeterminate
Color: Burgundy
Season: Mid to Late-Season
Unusual pear-shaped fruit and burgundy color. Good yields of 4-6 oz. fruit with excellent, rich flavor. Harvest when shoulders are still green for best flavor. Potato-leaf plants.



Nyagous

Color: Purple-Black Season: Mid-Season
Beautiful, smooth, round tomatoes that are dark mahogany with dark grey-green shoulders. Firm and blemish-free 6 oz. tomato with lots of sweet, complex fruit flavors and a clean acidic finish. Up to 6 fruits to a cluster.

Aunt Ruby's German Green

Season: Mid-late Season

Green beefsteak with sweet flavor with a spicy undertone. Globe-shaped fruits, 12-16 oz., with light green skins at maturity and a hint of yellow. Flesh is green blushed with pink, meaty, and flavorful.

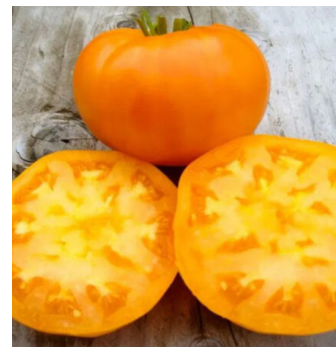

This beefsteak has few seeds and a fantastic sweet, tangy flavor. Delicious rich flavor with a good acid/sugar balance. Very productive.



Amana Orange

One of the most flavorful of the early producing beefsteaks. Vigorous plant produces meaty 1 lb. fruits.



Persimmon

Originally from Russia, this beefsteak type has very large, 1 lb. fruits, with high flavor, low acidity, small seed cavity.



Pineapple

Color: Red/Yellow

Season: Mid to Late-Season

Very large, up to 2 lbs. each. Yellow fruit has red marbling through the flesh. The flavor is very sweet and fruity; good yields!



Thorburn's Terra-Cotta

Color: Brown-orange

Season: Mid-Season

Honey-brown skin, orange-pink flesh, and green seed mass, this is an eye-catching slicer with an out-of-this-world flavor.

Multi-Colored and Striped Varieties



Ananas Noire

Days: 85

Plant Size: Indeterminate

Color: Green/Red/Yellow/Purple

Season: Late-Season

AKA Black Pineapple, the skin has shades of green, purple, orange, red and yellow. Bright green flesh has bursts of red streaks. 1.5 lb. fruits.



Berkeley Tie-Dye

Days: 65-75

Plant Size: Indeterminate

Color: Multi

Season: Mid-Season

Compact plants produce beautiful 8-12 ounce fruit with a very sweet, rich, dark tomato flavor.



Berkeley Tie Dye Green

Days: 75-80

Plant Size: Indeterminate

Color: Green/Red

Season: Mid-Season

The stripes have an iridescent look, and the interior is a rainbow of colors. The flavor is a combination of spicy, sweet and tart.



Big Rainbow

Days: 80

Plant Size: Indeterminate

Color: Yellow w/ Red Blush

Season: Mid-Season

A big, sweet-tasting yellow fruit with a red blush on the blossom end and inside.



Evil Olive

Color: Marbled Green and Red

Season: Mid-Season

Plum-sized fruit, very productive plant, ripens slowly, starting out an olive green and lightening up with red streaks when ripe.



Hillbilly (Potato Leaf)

Color: Tie-Dyed Yellow/Red

Season: Late-Season

Gorgeous bi-color beefsteak, great for slicing. Beautiful yellow 1 lb. fruits are streaked with red on the blossom end. Sweet and juicy.

Cherry Varieties



Black Cherry

Days: 70
Size: Indeterminate
Color: Purple
Season: Early to Mid-Season
The only true black cherry. Clusters of 1" round, purple/mahogany cherries. Fruits have sweet, rich, complex flavors.



Green Grape

Days: 78
Size: Indeterminate
Color: Green
Season: Mid-Season
High yields of 1-2 oz yellow-green cherry tomatoes with lime-green color on the inside. Surprisingly sweet and flavorful.



Pink Princess

Days: 65
Size: Indeterminate
Color: Pink
Season: Early Season
Large and early for a cherry, its thick skins, somewhat resistant to cracking, detracts not one iota from the eating experience.



Large Red Cherry

Days: 70-75
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Red
Season: Mid-Season
Sweet, bite-sized fruit is slightly larger than other cherry tomatoes.



Sun Gold Cherry

Days: 55
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Orange
Season: Early-Season
A golden orange cherry with a very sweet flavor. Produces in warm and cold conditions. Fruit matures quickly, heavy producing plant.



Sweetie

Days: 65
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Red
Season: Early-Season
Classic red cherry. Prolific plant produces many 1" fruit in clusters.



White Cherry

Days: 75
Plant Size: Indeterminate
Color: Pale Yellow
Season: Mid-Season
Ripen to a pale yellow. 1/2", round fruit - sweet but not too sweet, and are borne from very productive vines. Great for snacking or salad.

Eggplants



Black Beauty

Days: 80

Tender, tasty purplish-black fruits are great in a variety of dishes. Excellent breaded or fried. Plants produce 4 to 6 large fruit, or more if kept harvested and well watered. For best quality, harvest before its glossy, dark skin begins fading to dull purple.



Listada de Gandia

Days: 75

This egg-shaped Italian beauty has 5 to 6" long fruits, purple with irregular white stripes. Mature plants set well under high heat and tolerate drought well. Thin skin does not need to be peeled for cooking.



Long Purple

Days: 80

Long Purple should be harvested when the fruit is 8"-10" long and the skin is still shiny. It's better to harvest eggplants a little young (6") rather than wait until they are overly mature with dull skin, plentiful dark seeds, and bitter taste.



Rosa Bianca

Days: 80

Colorful, light pink-lavender fruit with white shading. Rich, mild flesh is very popular with chefs and gardeners alike! No bitterness.
